Civil Registration is specifically the universal, continuous, permanent, and compulsory recording of vital events. These include births, death, partnerships, as well as separations. Furthermore, by successfully registering this information, governments and international agencies gain vital statistics on population dynamics, health, and inequities. And as a result, can use these insights to improve economic growth and the well-being of citizens. Birth registration is of course an essential step towards the creation of an effective CRVS system. Birth registration should therefore be easy, fast, and universal. However, at present, the worldwide availability of CRVS systems is severely limited, with striking consequences:

- The births of a quarter of children under the age of 5 have never been officially recorded.
- About one-fifth of the world's population lives and also dies without a legal identity.
- Worldwide, two-thirds of deaths are never registered.
